We will cover approximately 2 sections per day. The required sections are as follows:

Exams: There will be 1 midterm and 1 final. The midterm will be on **Monday, July 17** during the regular class period (this is subject to change if necessary). The final will be during the scheduled final period (consult the course schedule). The midterm will 1.5 hours, the final will be 3 hours. Calculators and books/notes are NOT ALLOWED.

Homework: I will assign homework weekly. You are expected to solve EVERY problem in detail. These problems will *usually* be handed in each Monday AT THE BEGINNING OF CLASS and the grader will grade and return them the following week. LATE HOMEWORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED except in extreme situations. Please do NOT slip homeworks under my office door since I will disregard them. You are also expected to read in depth each section of the book that I cover. Toward the last week of the semester I will FINALIZE your homework grades. This means that you will need to check your homework grades BEFORE THAT TIME if you feel the need. Note that my policy is: I DO NOT alter how homeworks have been marked by the grader except in the case where the score has been misadded.

Grades: The final will comprise 40% of your grade, and the homeworks and midterm will each comprise 30%.
